Cystic fibrosis (CF) is a rare, life-threatening genetic disease that primarily effects the lungs and digestive system. It causes thick, stick mucus to build up in the airways and other organs leading to severe respiratory and digestive problems. Over time, this can result in lung damage, chronic infections, and complications that shorten life expectancy and decrease quality of life. Currently, there is no cure for CF.

Inspired by founder Travis Suit and his daughter Piper, who has CF, the foundation focuses on improving quality of life for those living with cystic fibrosis.
